Ordering Lunches 101

As a reminder, parents are now responsible for ordering lunches through the HotLunch software on your desktop computer or through the app. It is easiest to add funds to their account and then select lunches that they want. After creating their account here are the steps to getting their order selected.

- 1. Click on 'Add Funds' from the left hand of the screen
- 2. Add the amount that you desire to put on your account and click 'Submit'.
- **3.** The next screen will ask if you want to add bank information
- **4.** Follow the steps to add banking information.
- 5. Now that they have credit on their account they can select lunches for their children. Make sure to select the

- correct lunch menu from the dropdown menu at the top of the screen.
- 6. Select the lunches that you desire to purchase and click on 'Checkout'.
- 7. You need to click the circle to 'Use Available Credit' to pay for the meal. If this step is not done the order will not be placed and your child will not have a meal.
